

# Oscar-Nominated Actor Tells Descansos Stories

As a fictional movie, *Descansos* may spark some serious debate regarding the controversial issue of roadside memorials. And now, thanks to Liam Neeson (*Schindler's List*, *Narnia*, *Star Wars*), a new documentary brings this global issue even further into the public spotlight.
